Asset sale

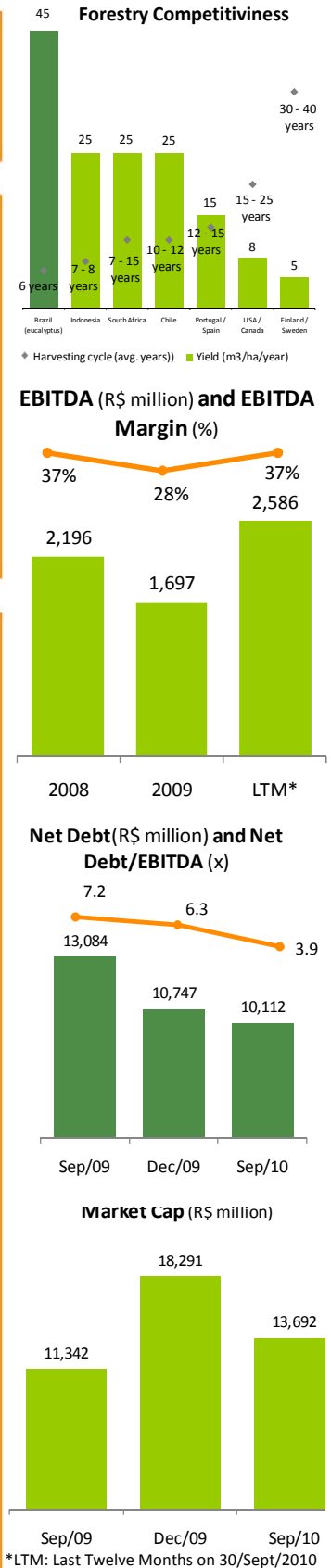
Fibria announced, on December 21st, 2010, that has accepted a proposal offered by Suzano related to the sale of the assets which includes industrial properties, forests and land that together comprise the stake of the Company at the Conpacel – Consórcio Paulista de Papel e Celulose – and also the acquisition of the installations and other assets of the KSR paper distribution operation. The total price of the transaction is R\$1.5 billion. The Conpacel asset sale shall be completed until January 31, 2011, and the closing of the acquisition of the KSR Assets shall occur until February 28, 2011. This transaction is in line with the Company's (i) strategy to focus on its pulp core business; (ii) growth plans; and (iii) liability management plan.

Carlos Aguiar honoured by IBEF

Carlos Augusto Lira Aguiar, Fibria's CEO, was honoured by the IBEF (Brazilian Institute of Finance Executives), as the Finance Personality of the Year for his work at Fibria and his broader contribution to the country's economic development. This award, which was created in 1987, highlights professionals from Brazil's major corporations and government bodies.

Sustainability: Fibria selected to the ISE and ICO2 indexes

Fibria was announced as one of the 42 companies in the BM&FBovespa's Efficient Carbon Index (ICO2), which aims to improve the adoption of environmental practices towards climate change by Brazilian companies. Fibria has also been selected to be on the BM&FBovespa Sustainability Index (ISE), which gathers companies listed at the São Paulo Stock Exchange that presents high commitment to sustainability and corporate governance best practices.
